DIRTY DETAILS ABOUT INSANITY ISLAND:

- **14 times the size of Giants Stadium**
- **Made with 14 million tons of fill – 10 times the volume of the Empire State Building**
- **Marine life and habitat will be killed and destroyed**

LNG (Liquefied Natural Gas) IS UN-AMERICAN:

- **LNG is a foreign fossil fuel from volatile sources like Russia, the Middle East, and Africa.**
- **LNG is dirty -- up to 40% dirtier than American natural gas and it will increase carbon dioxide emissions and climate change.**
- **American sources of natural gas are cheaper and plentiful—enough to meet our needs for 120 years.**

California, Connecticut, and New York have rejected LNG projects off their coasts. Governor Paterson must save the South Shore, too.
